The Assistant Secretary and Secretary had the pleasure of making the acquaintance of the Rev. C. Matheson on his visit to London in May.

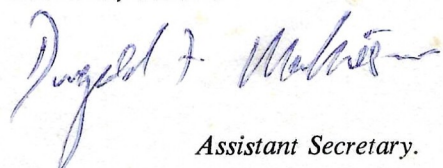
